East Cut: Appetizers

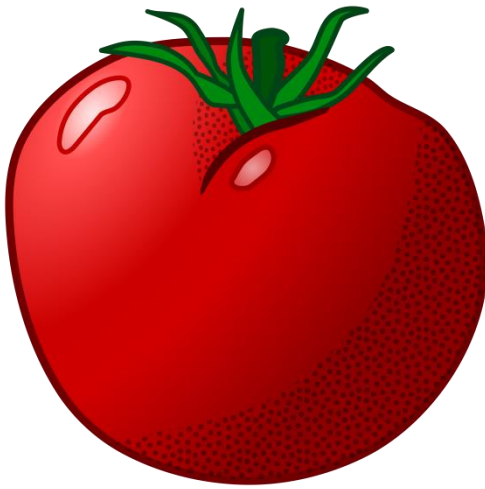
South Cut: Salads
